New Home & Home Improvements Incentive Program

Whether you're building a new home or making improvements to your existing home, a more energy efficient one helps you reduce your energy bills and improve comfort. Conserving energy benefits all Pierce Pepin Cooperative Services members and our communities. More energy saved means less has to be produced, improving the quality of our environment.

Wisconsin ENERGY STAR® Home (New Construction) Incentive

(Limit 1 per account)

Wisconsin ENERGY STAR certified homes on average are 25 percent more energy efficient than homes built according to the Wisconsin Uniform Dwelling Code. This incentive is available to members who construct an ENERGY STAR certified home that will be electrically served by PPCS. Visit www.energystar.gov for information.

- Up to \$500 toward cost of certification.
- Incentive applies to single-family homes only.
- Home must be built by a qualified Wisconsin ENERGY STAR builder.

Comprehensive Home Energy Audit Incentive

(Limit 1 per account)

This incentive is available to members receiving electric service from PPCS who hire a qualified contractor to perform a full energy evaluation with performance testing and recommendations for energy-saving home improvements based on the evaluation.

- Incentive will not exceed \$200 or 25% of the cost for the audit.
- Incentive applies to single-family homes only.
- Contact PPCS for more information and a list of qualified contractors.

Home Energy Audit Improvements Incentive

(Limit 1 per account)

This incentive is available to members receiving electric service from PPCS who complete the recommended improvements from the Comprehensive Home Energy Audit.

- Incentive will not exceed \$250 or 25% of the improvements.
- Incentive applies to single-family homes only.
- Improvements must show energy savings.

Wattmeter Lending Program

Wattmeters measure how much energy your appliance and other household equipment use by counting the kilowatt-hour (kWh) consumption. Simply plug your appliance or equipment into the meter and the meter into the wall outlet. Once you know the



kWh usage, it's easy to calculate your electrical expenses by the day, week or month. PPCS will loan a wattmeter to members receiving electric service free of charge. Contact PPCS for more information.

Terms and Conditions

General Eligibility

This program provides rebates/incentives for the qualifying purchase and installation of products and/or services for members receiving electric service from PPCS. Products and services must be purchased between July 1, 2007 and December 31, 2008. Applicants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Completed rebate/incentive forms and required documentation must be received by PPCS no later than January 10, 2009 (see incentive form on reverse side for details). Rebate/incentive will not exceed the purchase price.

Verification

PPCS reserves the right to verify sales receipts and/or the installation of products and services before issuing rebates/incentives. A random inspection may be conducted to verify installations. All rebates/incentives will be issued in the form of a credit to the member's electric account. **Please allow four to six weeks to process the rebate/incentive application.**

Program Modification

PPCS does not guarantee that the energy conservation products purchased and installed under this program offer will result in energy and cost savings. PPCS reserves the right to deny or limit any rebate/incentive. Rebates/incentives are limited to the available funds and may be discontinued before the end of the program period at the sole discretion of the cooperative.
