Applications for grants through Operation Round Up will now be considered by the board of directors on a quarterly basis.

Organizations, primarily non-profit groups with a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status, that support programs or projects that enhance the quality of life within our communities are encouraged to apply. Examples include emergency assistance (fires or natural disasters), public safety, health care, self-sufficiency, basic human needs, education, cultural environment enhancements, and combating economic and social problems.

Funding for Operation Round Up
